




# Information Guide For Schools

- Appoint a member of staff as Young Carers Champion to ensure young carers have a trusted adult they can turn to.
- Arrange young carer awareness-raising for all pupils and staff
- Have a young carers policy in place
- Ensure existing policies reflect the specific needs of young carers
- Ensure staff know how to refer to local young carers support
- Ensure there is a young carers flag on your pupil management system and that it is being used
- Ensure transitions work considers the needs of young carers
- Make information about young carers available to staff, pupils and families (i.e. young carer noticeboard, school website, student planners)
- Review school enrolment process to identify parent(s), siblings or family members who have disabilities or other long-term physical or mental health conditions
- Sign up to the Young Carers Leads in Schools initiative with Nottinghamshire Carers Association to receive training, regular updates and resources
